The successful candidate is a demonstrated leader and communicator that will collaboratively oversee the formation of comprehensive treatment care programs for individuals with developmental/intellectual disabilities.

Under administrative direction, this position performs administrative work in the coordination, direction, and planning of treatment programs within a defined residential organizational area at the Beatrice State Developmental Center. Directly supervises Home Managers, QDDP, Shift Leaders and administrative support staff. Facilitates the coordination, integration and monitoring of comprehensive services including client's medical, educational, vocational, behavioral, psychiatric, residential and habilitative plan across 24 hours per day, 7 days/week. Develops organizational unit policies, procedures, goals and objectives. Ensure compliance with facilities policies and procedures, standards/regulations and Labor Union Contract. The ICF/DD Manager functions as a Qualified Developmental Disability Professional and Administrator On-Call.
