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# *Background*

- ❖ Case Managers are required to report to the State every death of a person with DD
- ❖ Med. Dir. reviews all deaths
- ❖ Some recurring themes
  - Not identifying certain risks
  - Not doing certain preventable measures

# *Fatal Four (Five?)*

- ❖ Constipation
- ❖ Seizures
- ❖ Aspiration
- ❖ Dehydration
- ❖ (?) Pica




# *New ISP Process*


- ❖ Person-centered planning
- ❖ Risk Tracking Record
  - Health
  - Behavior
  - Safety
- ❖ Mandatory Steps
- ❖ What is important to/for the person


❖ **15. Does this person routinely take any bowel medications (not including fiber)?**

❖ **Yes.**

❖ **A.** Add risk of *Constipation* to ISP. Consider supports needed to decrease risk of constipation. Ensure development of Constipation Protocol. Go to question 18.

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- ❖ **5. Does this person cough or choke while eating or drinking? (Do not include a rare cough or choke, such as one a year ago.)**
  - ❖ **A.** Add both risks of *Aspiration* and *Dehydration* to ISP. Consider supports needed to decrease the risks of aspiration and dehydration. Ensure development of Aspiration Protocol and Dehydration Protocol. Complete B below.

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- ❖ B. Must get or have had an evaluation of oral motor skills. This could be done by an Occupational Therapist or Speech/Language Pathologist and might involve a swallowing evaluation.
  - ❖ Evaluation does not show dysphagia → Protocols may be discontinued and the risks removed from the ISP. Go to question 6.
  - ❖ Evaluation does show dysphagia → Complete C below.
